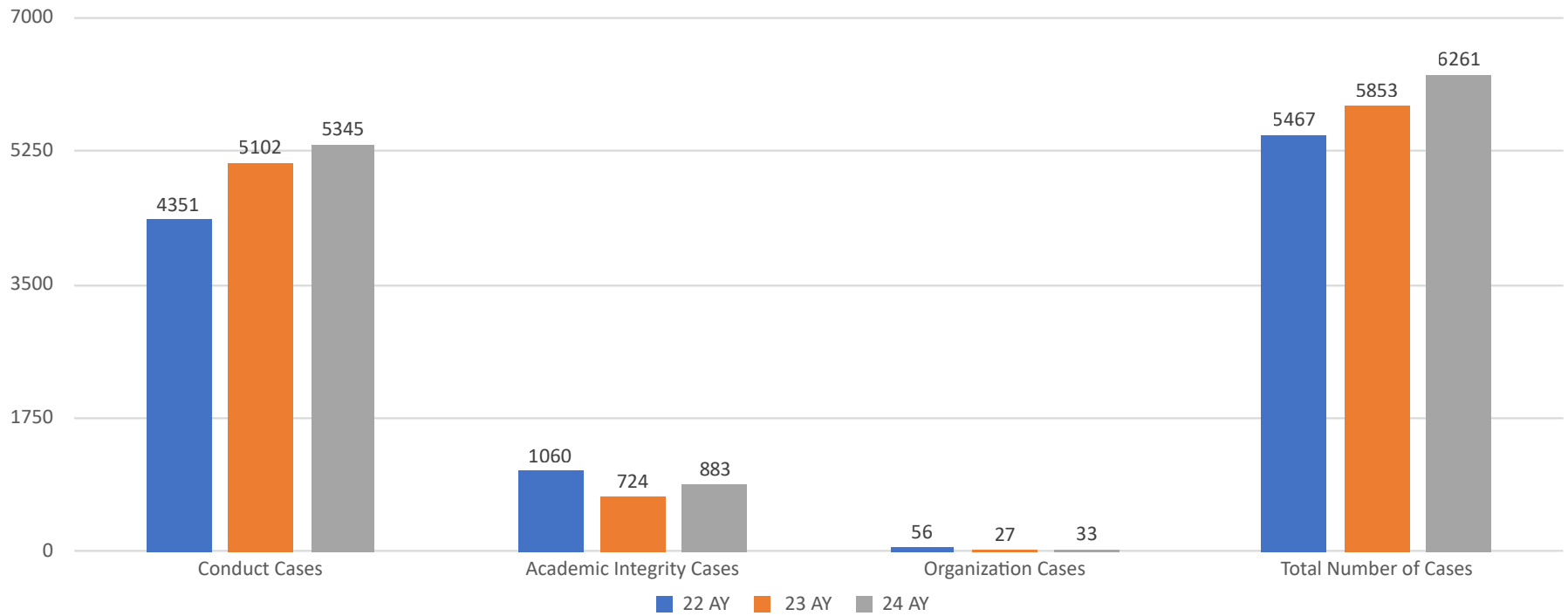


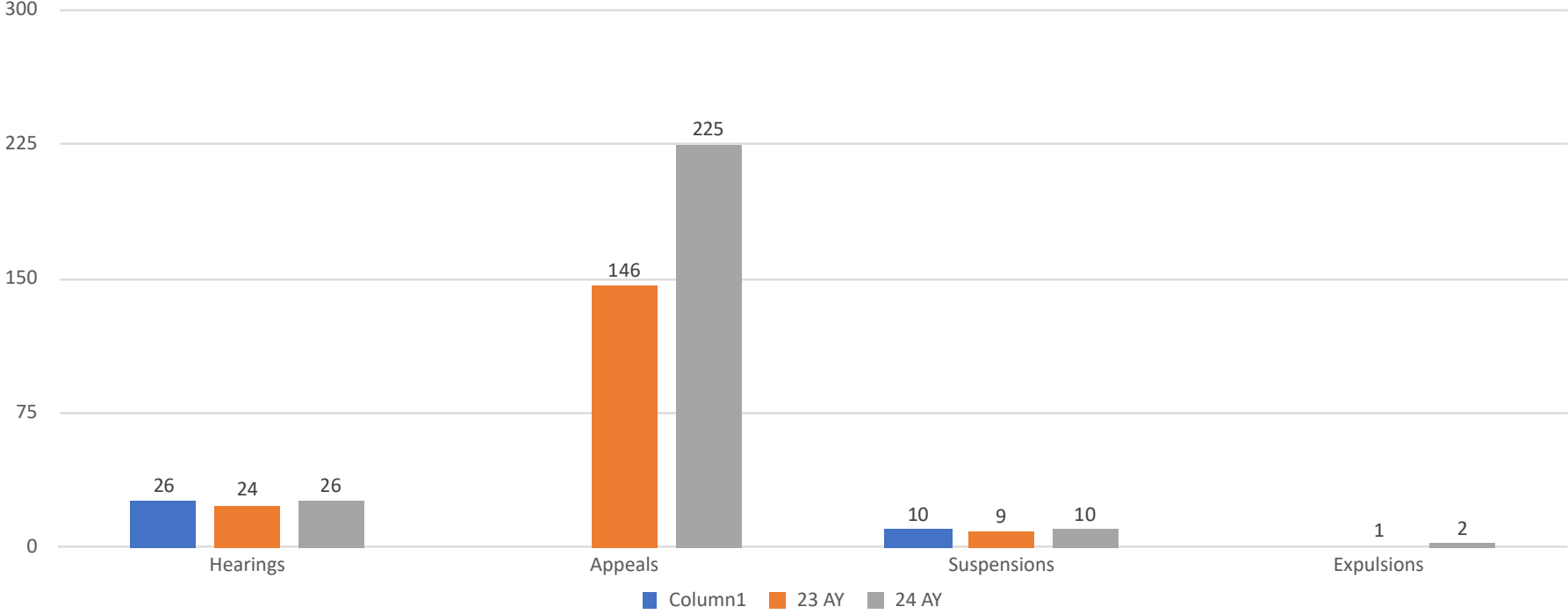
Office of Student Conduct 23-24 EOY data

- Significant increase in Academic Integrity violations from last year many of them are related to the use of artificial intelligence.

- Significant decrease in cannabis violations from last year.
- Significant decrease of violations in the College Avenue Residence Halls.

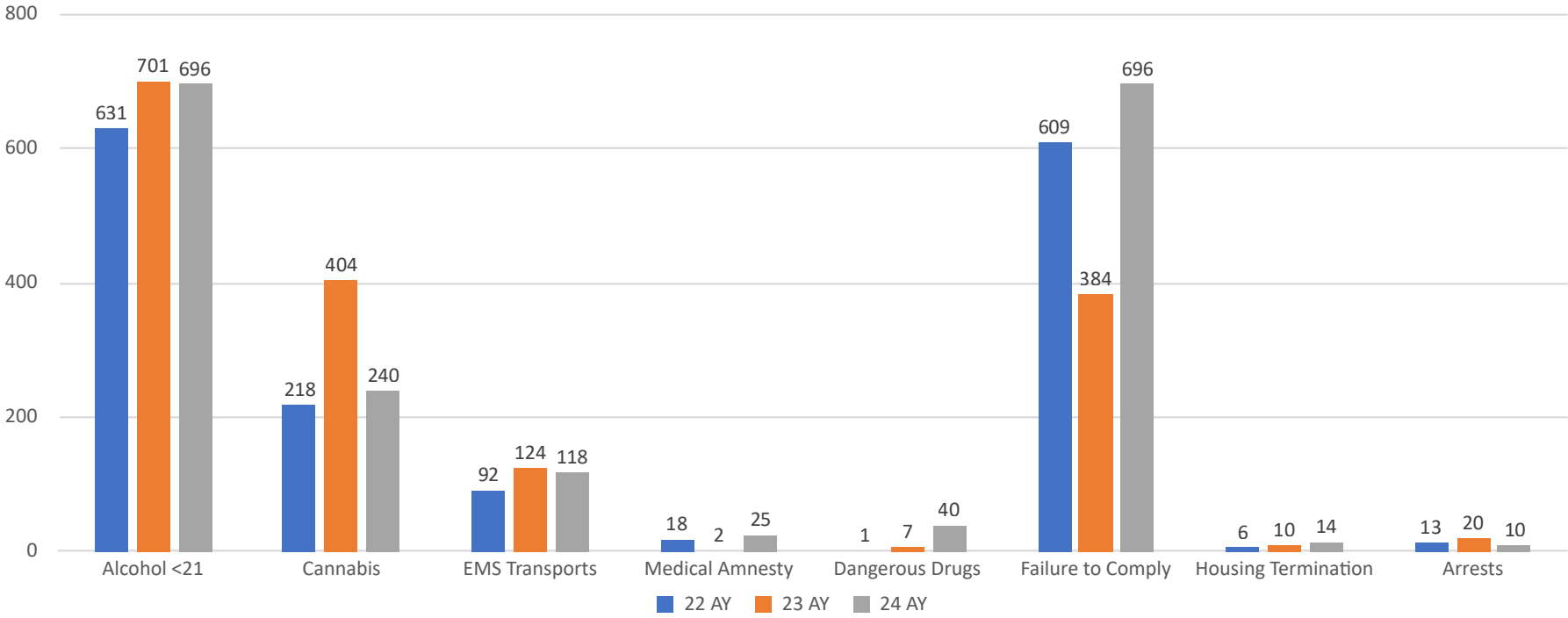

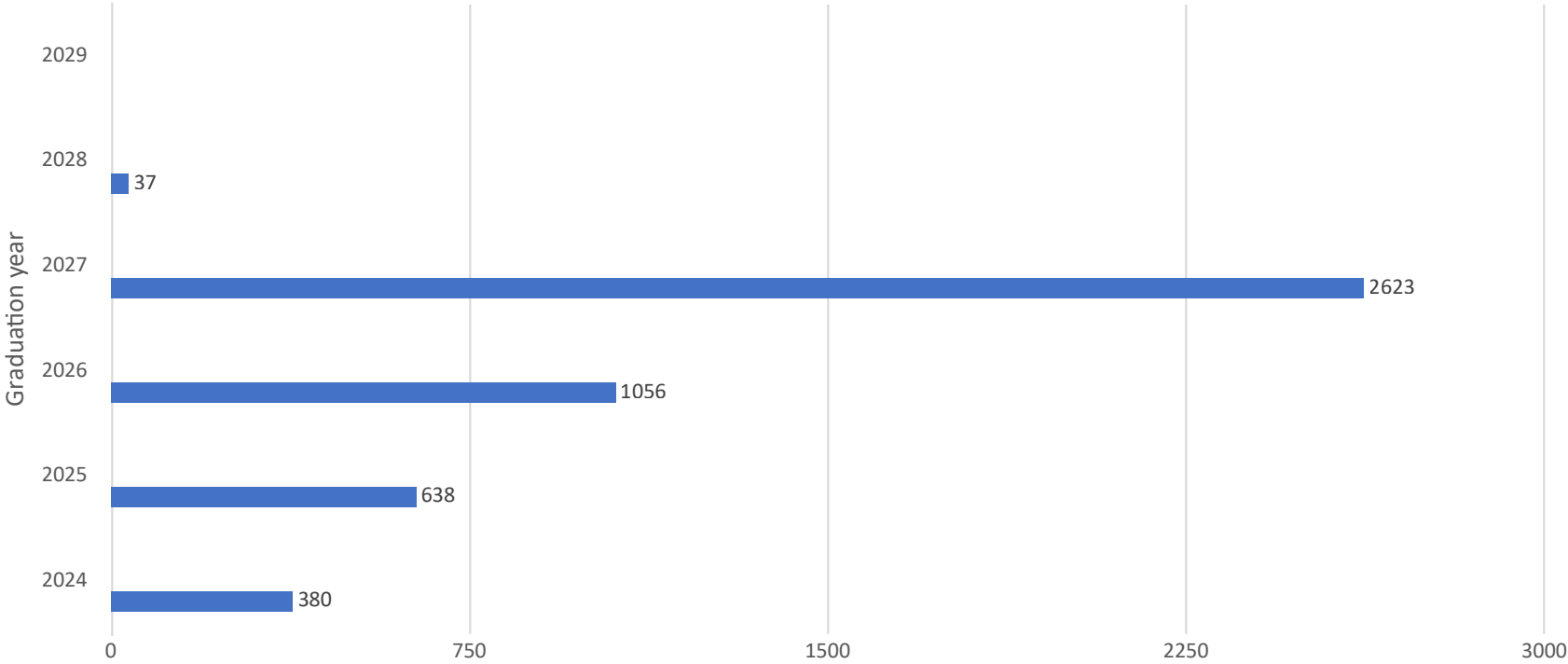
University Proceedings and Major Sanctions



Incident Totals by Violation Type

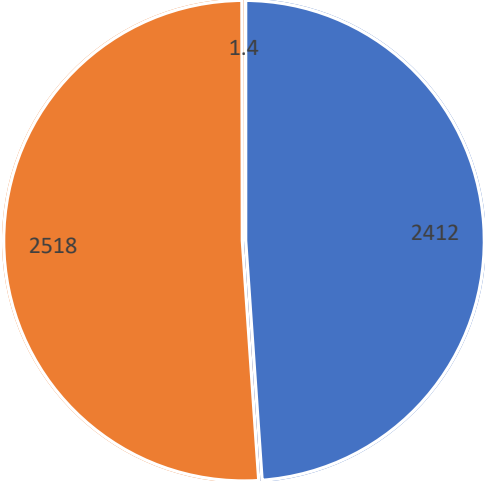

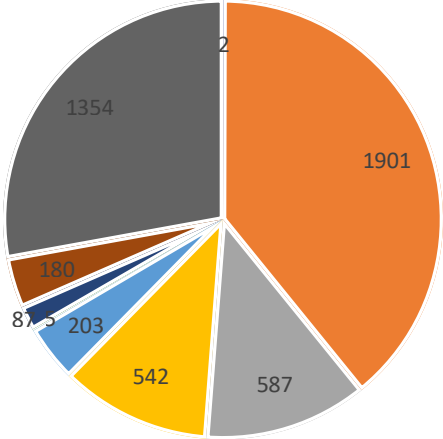

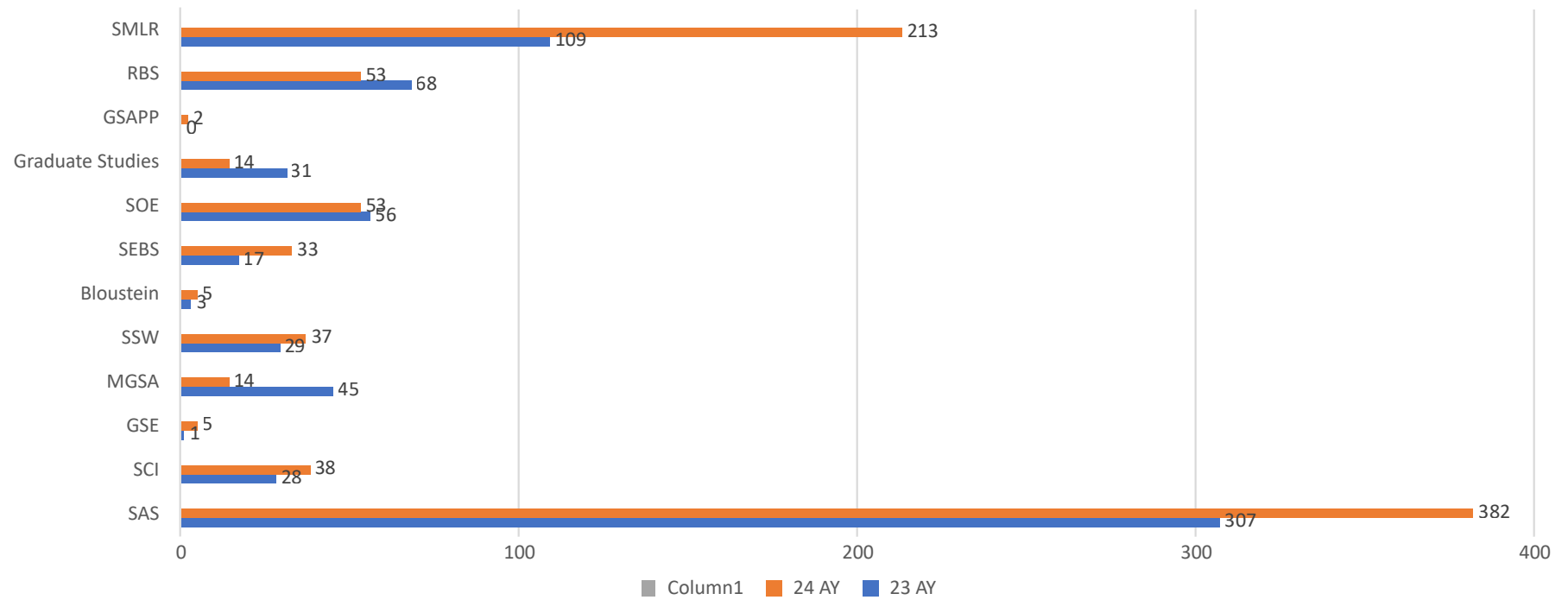

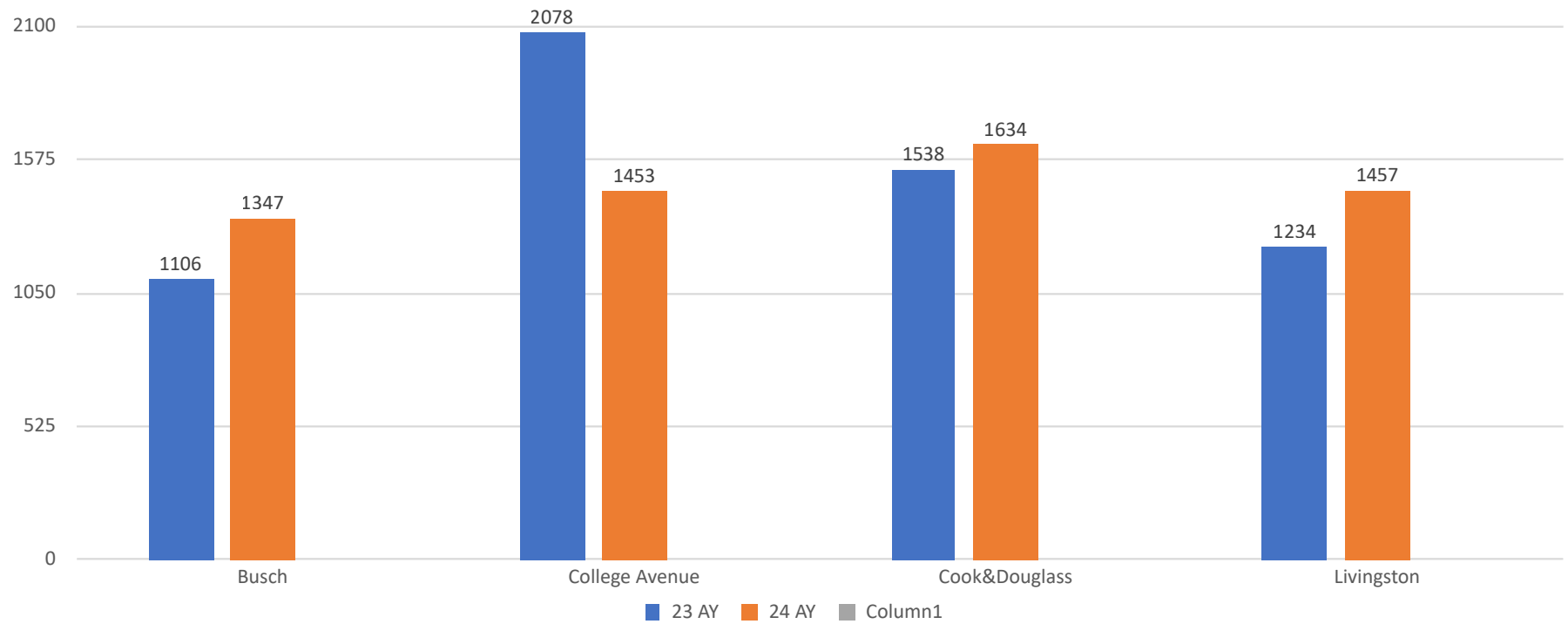

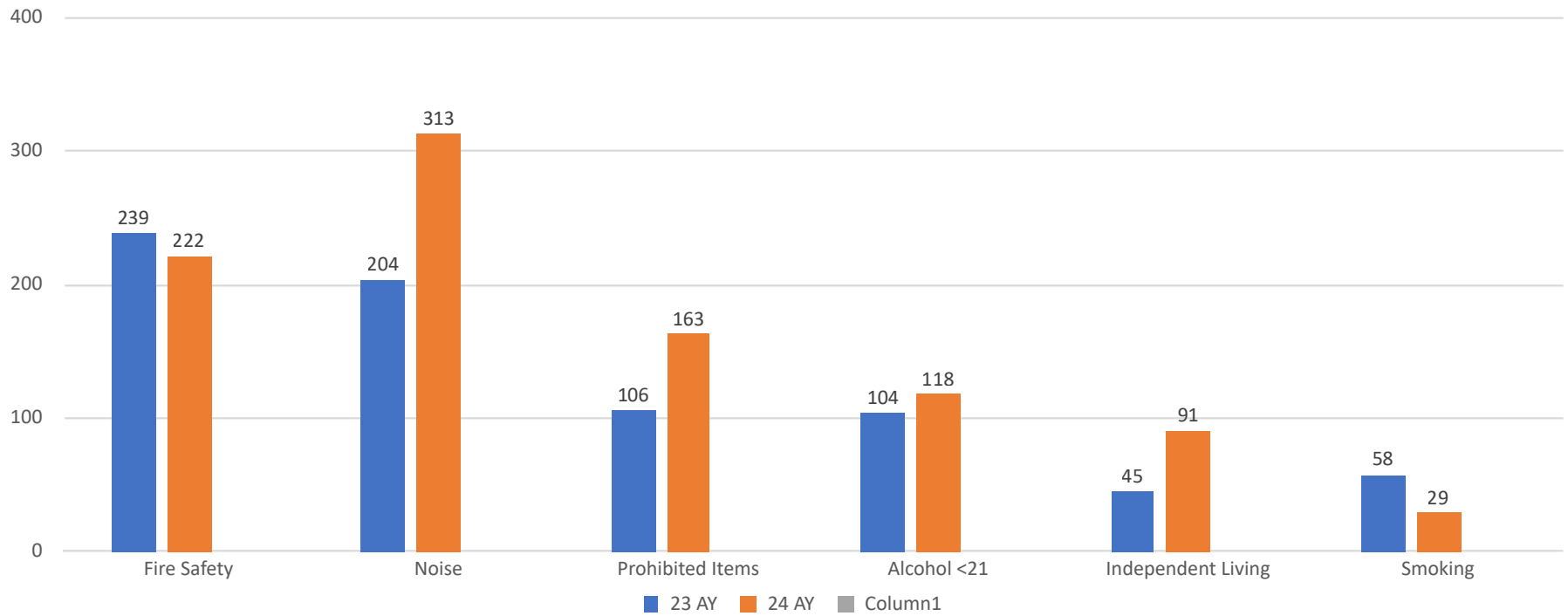
Total # AI Cases by School



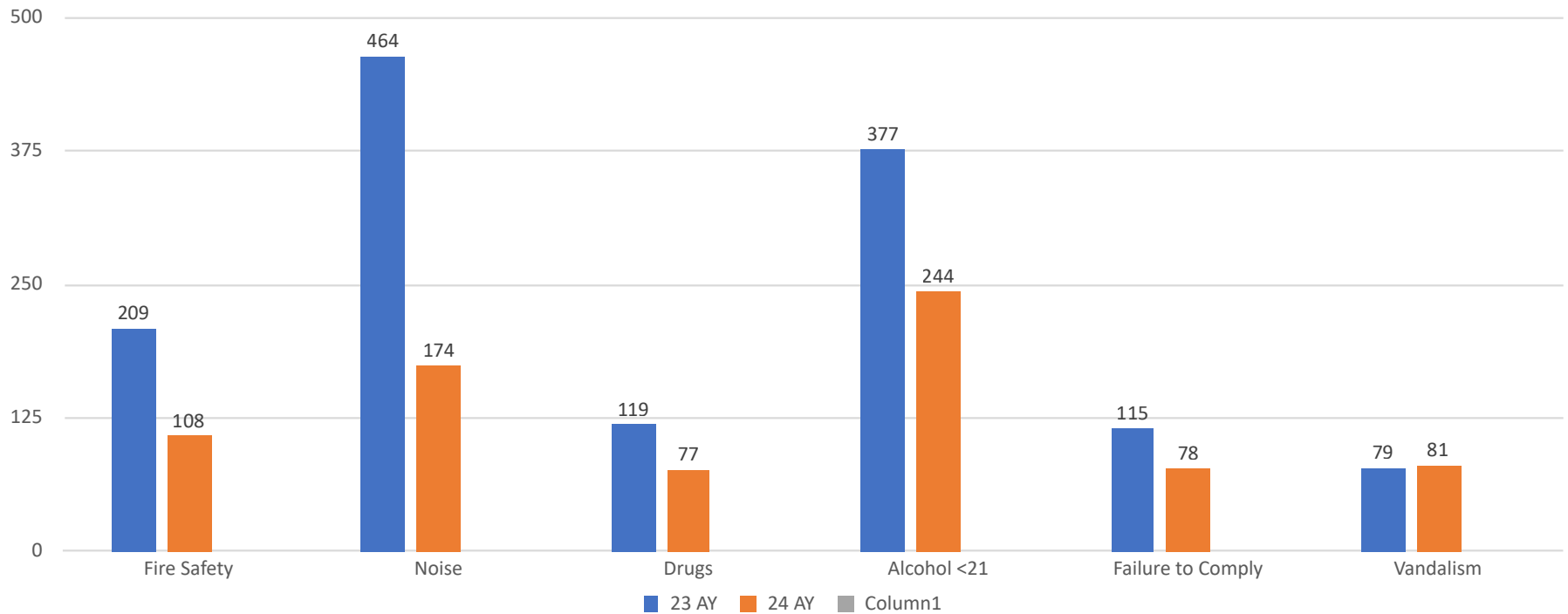
Total # of Cases by Incident Location



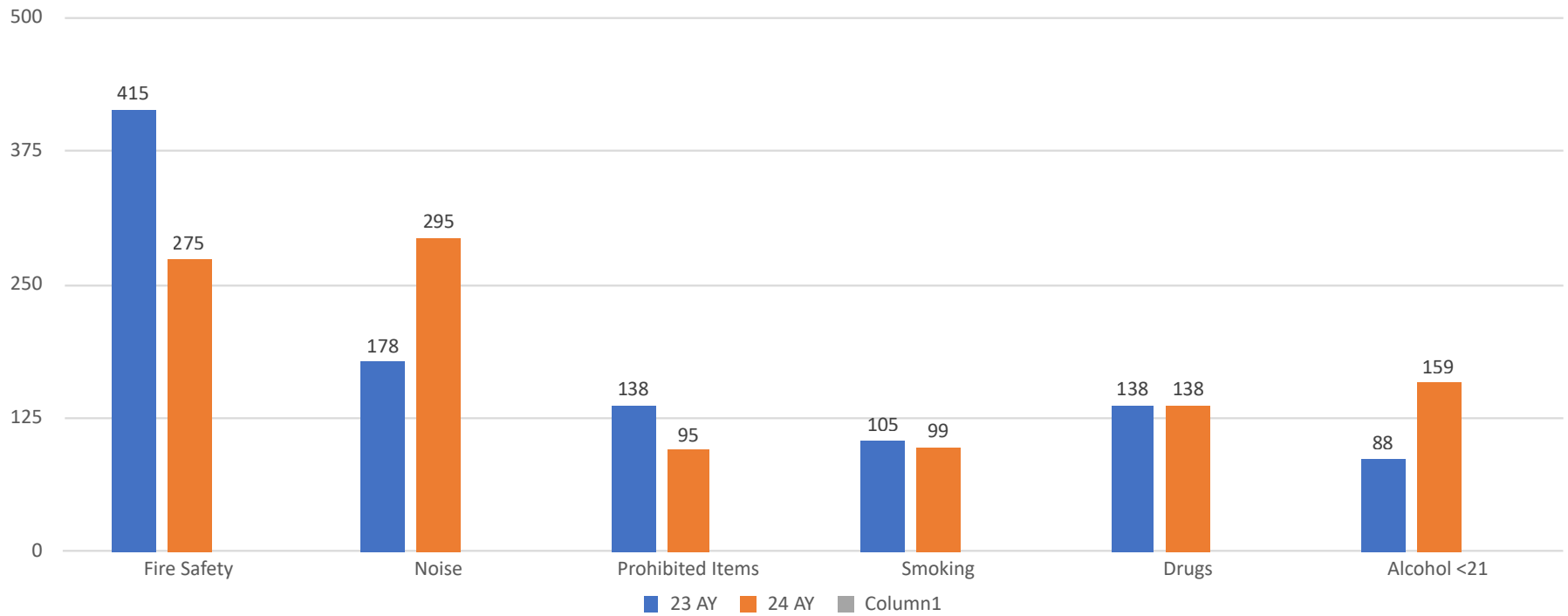
Top Violations on Busch



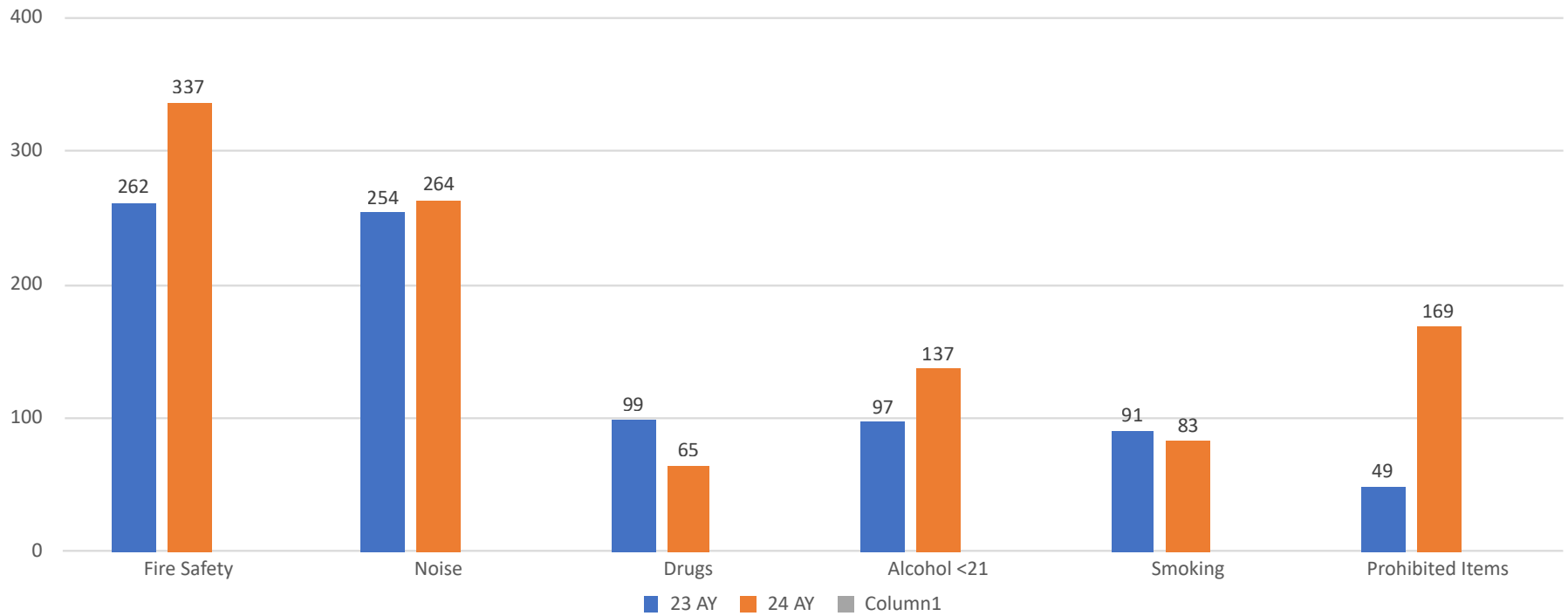
Top Violations on College Avenue



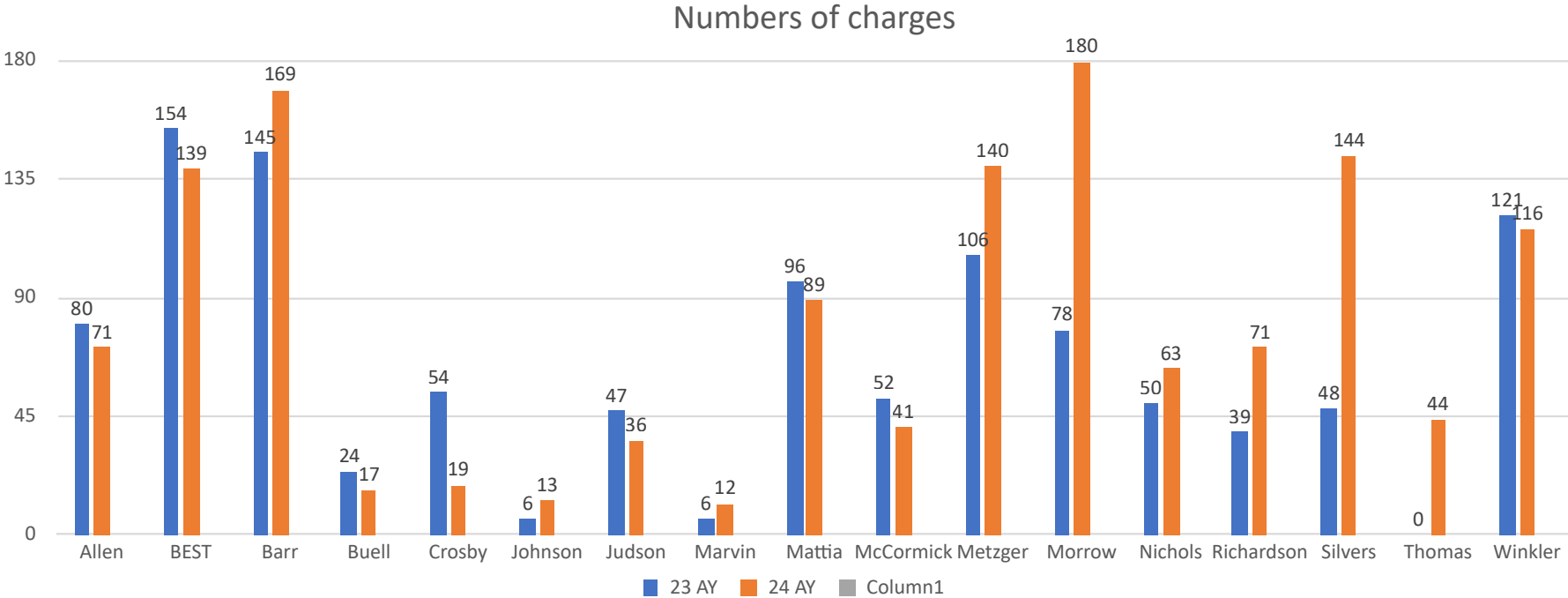
Top Violations on Cook&Douglass



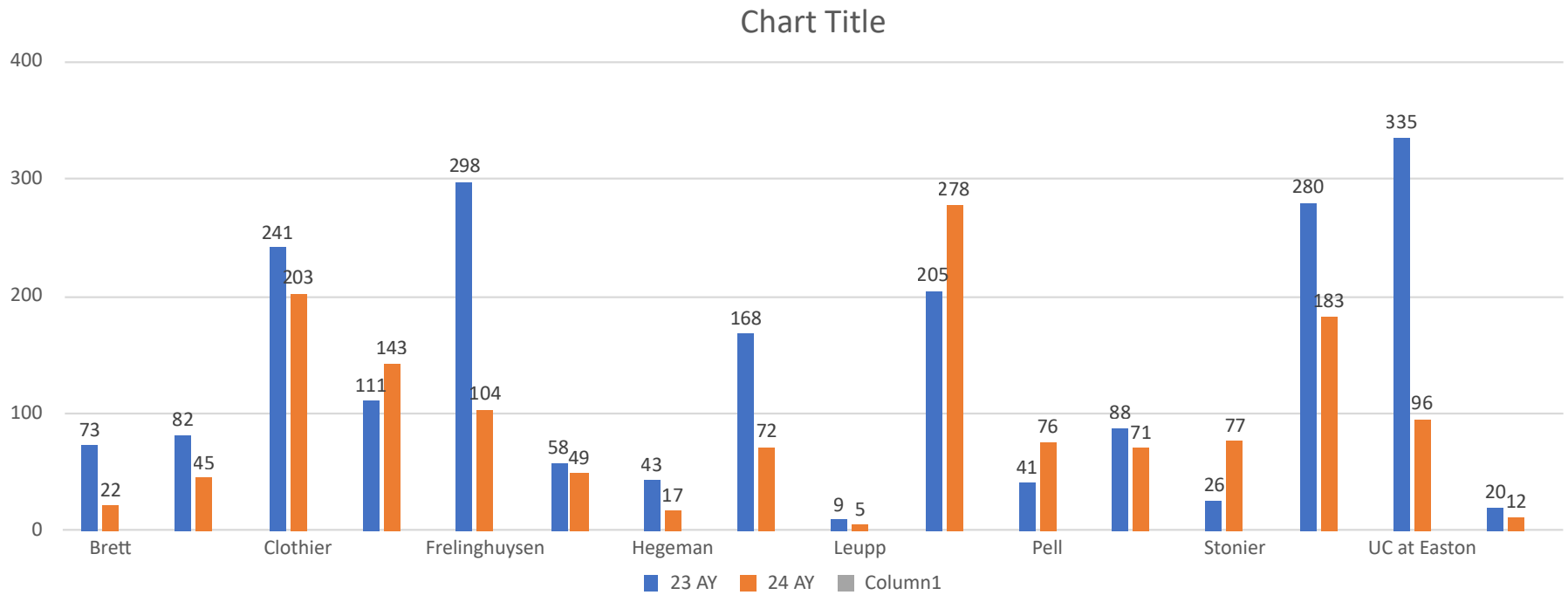
Top Violations on Livingston



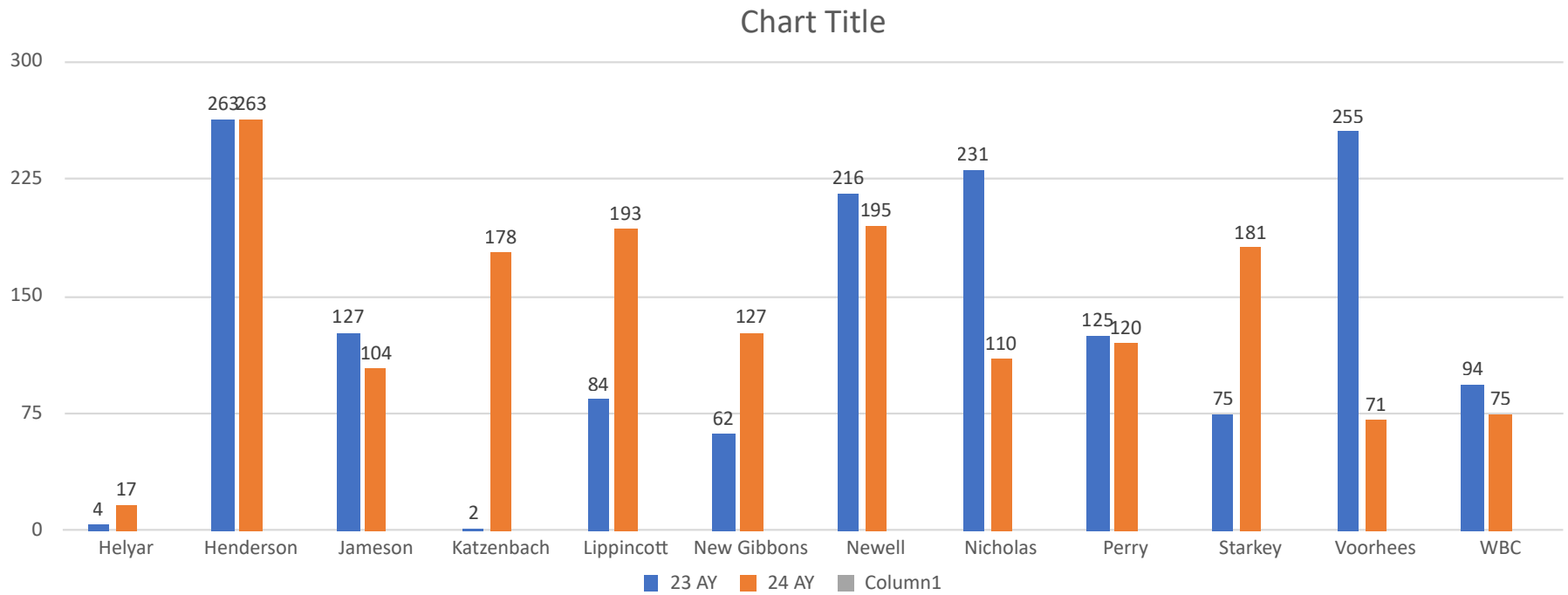
Busch Residence Halls Breakdown
